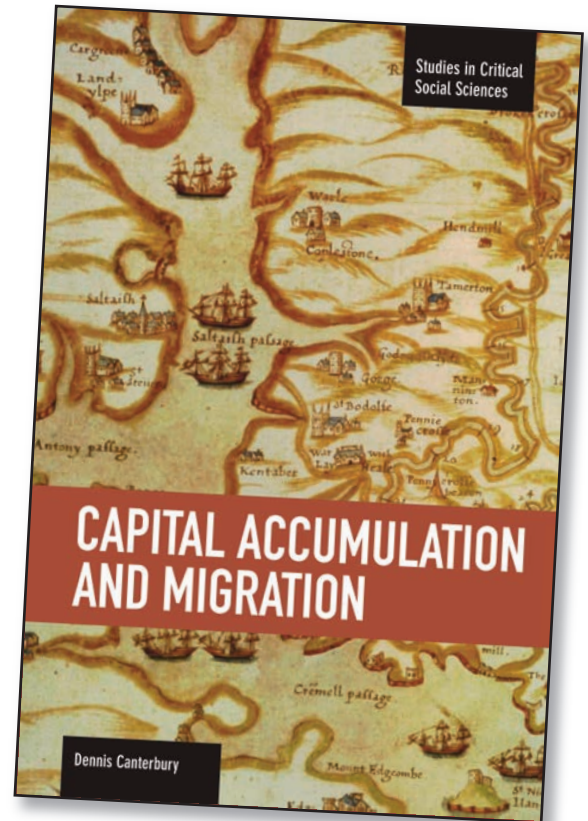

Capital Accumulation and Migration explores the subject of capital accumulation and migration, a topic that is remarkably absent in the voluminous literature spawned under neoliberal capitalism by the renewed interest in the impact of migration upon developing countries. This volume undertakes a critique of what literature exists and adds a critical dimension to it by analyzing the financialization of the migration processes. This work definitively shows that a central feature of neoliberal capitalism is the remodeling of the global political economy to facilitate capital accumulation from migration.
